DEVELOPMENTS OF R. MANIGANDAN

Manigandan is 17 Years boy from Edhapattu Village; he got admitted in our Learning centre on 6th March 2009.

While him entering into our Learning Centre he was studied up to 6th standard. Even though he studied in the normal curriculum school he knows nothing in reading and writing, he is zero in the money value, addition, subtraction and multiplication. He has thyroid problem, due to this his neck is prominent, and his speech is not clear and difficult to understand. He has difficulty to walk for a long distance; usually his relatives carry him during the hospital visit to JIPMER, Pondicherry, during his thyroid treatment. He is alone and not mingling with others easily.

Our continuous therapy and special education impacts in his development in the following ways. The continuous Thyroid therapy & treatment makes his neck loose, he can able to speak clearly, he can able to communicate with others easily. He is easily telling the Tamil Rhymes, his parents names, parents profession.

- He can able to say and write his name and his address
- He is able to say our country name, President name, Prime Minister Name and Chief Minister Name
- He is aware of the money value 1 Re, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50, and 100 Rupees
- He is knowledgeable about the 12 months of the year, weekdays, the date and days.
- He can say the correct time using the wall clock, wrist watches
- He is able to say and write the Tamil Alphabets அ to ங & க to ஞ
- He can able to count the numbers from 1 to 50, he can say the value in between any number
- He can able to do the simple addition math's 1 digits & 2 digits
- He can able to writ the simple known words if we dictate

His physical deformity, problem with walking is rectified by the continuous Physiotherapy, he can able to walk any long distance independently.

His self care and cleanliness improved a lot. He is regular with his morning activities ie., bathing, toileting, dressing, combing, grooming. He is wearing clean and tidy uniform; he is coming to our Learning Centre in the tuck in uniform. As soon he back to his home he uses to wear the civil dress.

NEW ADMISSION

Manigandan from Sevalapoondi Village, Gingee Taluk, Villupuram District. The parents Kali / Sudha, the parents are married with close relatives. Manigandan is the second son.

He got admitted in our learning centre on 19th August 2013. During the initial period he uses to cry always, it is very difficult to make him to eat. Now he mingling with all the children, he is used to our Learning Centre.

INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

On 15th August the 67th Independence Day is celebrated with grand manner. The children are enjoyed the celebration, we distributed sweets to the children. All the children honored the national flag. We conducted the song competition among our Learning Centre Children; Praveen Kumar won the prize in this competition. He is awarded with the scale as a reward.
