Know About the Child

Sri Murugan, 4 Years old child from Thazhangunam Village. Father Amavasai, Mother Sujatha. The child joined in our Learning Centre on 5th July 2011.

While admitted in our Learning centre the child laid down as we kept in the floor. He uses to cry while laid down in the floor, he likes to hold him in all the time.

Now he can roll down in the floor, he is attentive to our voice, if we call with his name he shift his head to listen who called him. He can move his legs like cycling in the air while lay down in the floor. He can able to sit down in the corner chair for some times.

Previously he use to eat the rice and idly with sugar only. Now he can able to eat the rice and idly with sambar, Reasam, he likes very much the biscuits and the milk. During the snacks time if we cross him to give the milk & biscuits to other children, he use to cry asking for it.

He responds to our voice, if we call him by his name he use to laugh. If we say him to call Aaya (Grannie) he used to call Aaya to the care taker.

MAY – 2013

In May month due to the severity of the summer the Learning centre announced holiday for 15 days. We planned to re-open the Learning centre on 3rd June 2013

April and May is the peak summer happen in Tiruvannamalai District. Many times it reaches the maximum temperature among the 32 Districts.

Due to the peak summer the vegetable prices and food products are increased rapidly.

Many Places we are facing water scarcity in the town and the villages.

The monsoon rain is not started in the regular period, which affects the agriculture and made the price hike.

Parents Meeting

The parents Vs Staff consultative meeting took place on 6th April 2013. On this Saturday 27 parents attended this consultative meeting. We discussed about the following topics.

Mrs. Devi – Representative of Kalki Self help group shared the information that two more new members Mrs. Ettiyammal & Mrs. Kala joined in the KALKI Self help group.

Purushothaman mother shared that his son is very often forget many things.

The next three months target for their children are shared with the parents.

Sarathi's Mother shared the information that he ask many question with her, 1. Why you are not give care like his younger sister. 2. Why the father I doesn't like him, 3. Is it he is not able to walk properly.

The mother shared the information twice they gave Rs. 3,000/- to a Village Administrative Officer to get the maintenance grant. But they are not able to get it. We informed her the procedure to get the maintenance grant and we also told her not to give any bribe.

Barathy's mother shared the information that they took him to the hospital in Tiruvannamalai for his Tongue Tie problem. The doctor's suggested to undergo minor surgery for this problem which costs Rs. 10,000/- We informed her that this type of surgeries are taken care free of cost in Sri Ramachandra Medical College and Hospital, Chennai. So we told them to take him to that hospital. We also gave reference letter to the hospital.

Purushothaman, Periyasamy, Palani, Sharmila, Ranjani, Deepak, Gunapriya's parents/relatives are shared the information that they are receiving the maintenance grant for their children.



Staff Meeting

The staff meeting took place on 6th April 2013, we were discussed about the Learning Centre activities and plans of the Learning centre. The following points were discussed in this meeting.

- The next evaluation has to complete on or before 15th May 2013
- The staff are advised to be punctual to their work
- The vehicle running expenses volunteer contribution increased up to Rs. 500/-
- The contribution should be collect by the Driver Sathish
- The staff team member are motivated to increase the local contribution

- The school vehicle repair works has to complete as soon as possible and the updated log book has to maintain
- The staff team members are provided with the information that we are planning to shift the Learning centre to the new building in the June Month
- A donor in Chennai assured to provide cheppal stand, chair, stand, cot to our learning centre, we have to bring it using the vehicle

- The vehicle Fitness Certificate work should complete on Tuesday
- Next week we have to submit the Locomotor Disability, MR, CP, MD, MI and Visually Impaired List to the District Differently Abled Welfare Officer, Villupuram for the Identity Card, Medical Camp, etc.,
- We have to make a remainder in the District Differently Abled Welfare Office, Villupuram that the amount of the food grant for the last year is not received till date.

Medical Treatment Information

On 2nd April Praveen Kumar brought to our learning centre, he is not able to stand, we took him to the private medical practitioner in Avalurpet. The doctor examined and told that he may got affect with brain fever which affects his mobility. So he advised immediate attention, so he referred him to the higher institution JIPMER, Pondicherry for further treatment. We took him immediately to the JIMPER Hospital, Pondicherry. The doctors done the needed medical investigations, also made the scan, the result shows that he has old injury which requires immediate surgery. On the same day he is operated, after the surgery he got infection and he is in hospital till now.

Logeswaran's Plaster re applied on 18th April.

Barathy's parents took him to the Ramachandra Medical College and Hospital, Chennai. We provided the reference letter on 19th April, the doctors done the medical examination and advised to come on 20th May for next check up.

Local Contribution

Home Based Assessment Visit

We met Thamizharasan and his mother in their village bus stop. We had small discussion in the bus stop itself. The mother says that very often he is asking for eatables. He can repeat the words what we say, he can say the Tamil Alphabets m to ` and the numbers 1-10. He also can say the week days in Tamil and English. For writing we have to hold his hand for the writing co-ordination. The mother feels good gradual development with his child Thamizharasan.

While we went to Rajeswari's house she is in sleep, she is not taken bath, her hygiene condition is very poor, she is not cared for her self hygiene. Even though she studied up to 8th standard in a normal school she can able to write two letters in Tamil Alphabet. Now she can write the complete alphabet in Tamil, she can able to say the 12 months of a year. She is not mingling with others, she is not playing with others, for long time she use to sit alone and talk herself. She is not doing the day to day activities works, she use to smile while she is alone. She understand our commands

for certain extent only. We explained the goals of this quarter to her mother, the mother said I don't know anything about it.

Sudhagaran is alone in his house, no body is with him, while we ask him he said that I will eat and sleep.

We went to Shanthi's house, she is watching the television with her younger brother. We found she is clean and tidy, While we discuss with the family members they said that she is studying in the evening hours, she shows good interest in the studies, she is helping in the kitchen activities also she is helping in cooking. She is treating the guests. The mother has only one suggestion that the mobility and the leg has no improvement, day by day her mobility is getting worse.

Shalini is not came to our learning centre for long time, during our visit no body found in the house, we came to know that she got affected with chicken pox so she is not able to attend the school.

Abisheka Priyan, we went twice to his house we are not able to meet the family members.

May 2013

Due to the severity of the summer the Learning Centre announced from the middle of May month. The staff team members are informed that they have to work without their monthly remuneration.

We are planning to re-open the Learning Centre on 3rd June 2013.

On 24th of May 2013 we shifted the furniture and the materials from the rented building to our own building.

The new building painting works are progressed in May month, The carpenter works are progress, the deposit for EB Connection paid.

As the school van is left for the Yearly Fitness certificate works, we rented the vehicle for the working days in May month.

A staff trained teacher resigned her job due to her personal reason.

On 20th May 2013 we received Rs. 1,16,000/- cheque towards food grant from Tamilnadu Government for Hariksha Learning Centre.

On 22nd May the District Differently Abled Welfare Officer, Villupuram and Revenue Divisional Officer, Villupuram are visited our Learning centre.

From March 2013 Give India Online contributing agency open the donation option in the Internet. From March to May we received Rs. 39,471/- as a cash contribution for various options.
