## NEWS of JUNE 2013

All the schools re-opened from 10<sup>th</sup> June 2013.

The oil corporation increased the petrol price three times in June 2013. On 1<sup>st</sup> of June 0.75 paise increased in petrol price per liter. Again on 16<sup>th</sup> June the petrol price increased Rs. 2.00 per liter. Again the petrol price is increased Rs. 1.82 on 28<sup>th</sup> June.

The oil corporation also increased the Diesel price on June 1<sup>st</sup> with 0.61 paise and again the Diesel price hiked on 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2013.



Due to the fuel price hikes, the vegetables and the food materials prices are increasing like anything.

We are getting less monsoon rain, which results rapid increase in the prices of Vegetables, Pulses, and all the food ingredients.

Unttarakhand is flooded, the heavy rain makes difficulties to the pilgrims, many thousands of pilgrims are missed, rescue operation by the militants saved many lives.

## *Information about the Child Sarathi*

The child Sarathi is 6 years old boy child, the father Karthik, mother Sangeetha, the child is coming from Edhapattu Village. The child joined in our Learning centre on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2012.

The child Sarathi's neonatal history shows that he is born with blue color. They consulted the child with the health nurse in their village. After half an hour the color in the body became normal. The parents treated the child in JIPMER Hospital, Pondicherry, Baby Hospital, Chennai.

Before admission to our Learning Centre he enrolled in the baby centre in his village. He is not taught even the alphabet. He is not able to walk, he use to move by four legs.

Our teams one year effort makes the result and good improvement in his ADL and education. Now he is good in communication, he understands our interaction and responding for it. Our team members fixed the task of 1<sup>st</sup> standard curriculum Tamil, English and Maths. He identifies the Tamil Alphabet letter அ to ஊ, he can say அ to ஊ, he can say the simple words அம்மா to எ.ஃகு, He can sing and memorize the first three songs in the text book. He can say the English Alphabets.

He can write and copy the letters அ to ஊ, 1-5 and A to J, He is able to fix some selected peg boards.

Our therapy session achieved that he is able to walk with support.

## *Parents Meeting*

The parents gathering and discussion meeting took place on 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2013. In this group discussion 23 parents / relatives are actively participated. We were discussed about various topics, the information are as follows:-



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- We shared the information that in July month the Uniforms and the foot wears will be issued to the children.
- We communicated with the parents that from 1<sup>st</sup> of July the Learning Centre will be operating in the new building.
- We provided the information that experts from abroad are arriving to provide special therapy and trainings, the parents are instructed to accompany their children to learn about the latest techniques to develop their children.
- The children performing good writing skill will be provided with the note books to make their daily home works, the parents are instructed to monitor the home works and need to sign it every day.
- The parents are provided with the information that the vehicle will not travel the small lanes in the villages, the vehicle will be stop in a main place in the village, the parents are requested to send off and receive the children from the stopping
- All the parents / relatives are requested and advise to pass on the message that they have to attend the parents meeting without fail
- The new care giver Miss. Buvaneswari is introduced to the parents relatives.
- The new three months target information shared with them
- The parents / relatives are informed that the maintenance grant of their children will be deposited in the bank by the District Differently Abled Welfare Office, they have to verify and ensure it with the bank by showing the passbook whether the maintenance grant is received for the particular period.
- The parents are provided with health supplementary food (HORLICKS) to compensate the nutritional deficiency of their children.

## ***Staff Meeting***

The staff meeting conducted on 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2013, we were discussed about the review and various development works, these are as follows

- The team members are informed to make the attendance enrollment for the newly admitted children
- The staff team members are instructed to make all the necessary steps to complete all the pending works of painting, carpenter works, the iron grill works, etc.,
- We shared the information that the experts from France are arriving in July



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- The team members are informed to make all the necessary steps to obtain the building stability certificate, sanitary certificate, no objection certificate from Fire & Rescue Department and FORM D from the Thasildhar for the new building for the Government Registration purpose
- Need to take the necessary steps to complete the uniform stitching and footwear purchase.
- The arrangements for the General Health Check Up, Eye Doctors Assessment Camp, Dental Assessment Camp need to start
- The long absentees students house visit has to done, to find out the reason why the children are not coming to the learning centre
- Try to explore the possibilities to obtain the vehicle running and maintenance expenses from the parents.
- The team members need approach the District Differently Abled Welfare Office, Villupuram for the Building Grant, Feeding Grant & the Teacher's Salary Grant.
