In the month of July 2015 a new child named Monisha, 13 Years from Thayanur Village got admitted in our Learning Centre. The child is with Mental Retardation. The parents are Father Name: Munusami, Mother Name: is Elammal. Monisha is having a younger brother, 7 years younger to her. He is normal in health and activities.

The birth history shows that the child is born after five year period of the marriage life of her parents, the marriage is consanguineous marriage. During the pregnancy the mother got health issues. The child is born in a hospital delivery with prolonged labour pain. As soon as the birth of the child is not cried and fed well. The child kept in the incubator for one day, the child is with normal birth weight.

Parents Meetings

Parents meeting took place on 4th July 2015, in this meeting 23 parents relatives are took part and discussed about various information. The discussion information are as listed below:

- This meeting is the first meeting after the summer vacation holidays
- We shared the information that now we are open children admission in the Learning Centre, if the parents / relatives came across any special need (Mentally Retarded, Cerebrally Palsied, Autism) children in their area, very well they can refer them for admission
- At present we have 10 vacant position in the Learning Centre, in this already 5 enquiries for admission is in progress
- Gokulakannan's mother shared the information that in her village she known a special need child
- Deepak's father used bad words for the incident (fell down and got injured) happened to his son last month
- We shared the information that in a normal school has the care taker who will take care of the entire school children
- But in our center we appointed 2 care takers who are taking care of the children of one class room strength of the normal school
- Gokul's parent complaint that while he is in the house he is not showing interest to wear the dress
- We shared the information to the parents relatives, every month after the parents meeting we are conducting a discussion and re-view meeting among the staff members to discuss many things happened and to plan the next month
- The parents relatives are informed that our well-wishers, supporters, organization and the staff team members are happy about a small changes happened in each child's life every day
- Our intention is to make the children independent, to be known their name, parents name, village, address and to make them to do their personal work themselves.
- Vignesh's parents are informed that very soon we have to apply Plaster for him otherwise the bone will become as Sudhagar
- The parents are informed that during Tuesday and Thursday the professional physiotherapist Mr Gandhi is visiting regularly to improve the mobility and to reduce the physical problem of the children
- The information shared to the parents that in June month a common medical screening camp organized to assess all the children's health
- The parent relatives are informed about the international therapy session continuation will be emerge from the third week of July
- The parents are provided with the information about the other activities of the organization
- The parents & relatives are requested to be in the bus stop to put their children in the school bus and to pick them from the bus stop
- The expenses per month is shared with the parents
- The staff commitment is shared with the parents / relatives and appreciated

Staff Meetings

Staff meeting took place on 4th July, the meeting is presided by Mrs. Sujatha, Correspondent and participated by the team members, Ms. Buvanewari – Special Educator, Ms. Vijalakshmi – Special Educator, Mr. Elumalai – Special Educator, Mr. Gandhi – Physiotherapist, Ms. Muniyammal – Caregiver, Ms. Lavanya – Care Giver, Ms. Kamatchi – Caregiver, Shanthi – Caretaker, Puspaa – Cook and Sathis – Driver.

The discussions are dealt with the following information

- At first we were discussed about the new admission of the children, the possibilities to extend the school bus and to found the route for option
- We were discussed about the new assessment and fixing up new goals for the children
- If needed we can use a divider (plywood) to separate the classroom
- The staff members are requested to keep clean and hygiene the class room
- While children are using the bathroom for urinal the staff should accompany them to teach them how to use it properly and to use adequate water to clean
- The staff members are informed that they can purchase the materials required for the assessment by next week
- Information about the arrival of the new special educator is shared with the staff team
- The arrival of the International Therapist from France, with the mission to teach the staff and parents about the latest techniques in therapy is shared with the staff members

On 22nd of July Deepak and Karthik had quarrel, in this Karthi hit Deepak's head which cause injury. For which we took Deepak to Dr. Venkatesan's Clinic. The doctor made one suture and provided the needed medication and injection.

In villages the tonsure and ear pricking is celebrated in grand manner. Our child Archana's ear pricking is celebrated on 19th July, the parents invited our team members. On behalf of all the team members our staff Ms. Lavanya took part in this function and provided the child with a gift.

International therapist Ms. Flori, arrived on 11th July, from France, KDM Foundation, with the mission to continue to teach the therapy, latest developments in therapy in the international standards, and to provide individual attention to our children. She visited our Learning Centre on 13th of this month, each and every activities are explained to her, We introduced the children, staff members to her.

On 15th July the staff members and parents who are attending the therapy training are gathered. Ms. Flori made a self-introduction with the parents and relatives. A recap of the old sessions by other trainees done, the parents and staff members are explained about their learning about the parts of body and its function, disabilities, and rehabilitative techniques, etc., Ms. Flori provided the information that she is from KDM France and to continue the session for the next six months, the parents and staff team members can approach any time for any explanation, clarification of doubts, etc.,



Apart from this Ms. Flori made an individual discussion on 17th July, with the parents / relatives of the children (Vimala, Buvana, Thamayandhi, Kala, Sujatha, Chitra and Shenbagam), in this meeting the discussions were made about previous learning, any doubts before proceeds to the further session, what are the requirements are discussed.

Again on 20th July the staff (Kamatchi, Shanthi, Lavanya) are called for individual discussion, she asked for the individual demonstration of the each staff member to expose their learning from previous sessions (ROM, Stretching, Strengthening, etc.)

On 27th July she teach all the members how to assess a Cerebrally Palsied child.
