- Clear information about the Dengue & Viral fever is furnished to the parents and the needed prevention measures and precaution is explained
- Also we share all the parents to give the nilavembu kudinir to all the children and adult to prevent the season diseases and Dengue fever
- o The school bus is waiting in a few bus stop (houses of the children) more than 10 minutes for one child, it is clearly informed to the parents that due to this other children are suffering, so they are guided to bring their children on time
- o Pavithra grandfather is not able to give clear information about the long absence, so we informed that during next meeting the Mother or Father need to attend
- We request all the parents should compulsory attend the 3 month once children development assessment
